TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office, at the Bank of England on Friday, the 3rd December 1965, at 1 p.m. for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act, 1877, the National Debt Act, 1889, and the National Loans Act, 1939, to the amount of £180,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000 or £100,000. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business day from Monday the 6th December 1965, to Saturday the 11th December 1965, inclusive, and will be due 91 days after date.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated, and the net amount per cent. (being an even multiple of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.

5. Tenders must be made through a London Banker, Discount House or Broker.

6. Notification will be sent by post on the same day as Tenders are received, to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part and payment in full of the amounts due in respect of such accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England by means of cash or by draft or cheque drawn on the Bank of England not later than 1.30 p.m. (Saturday 11 a.m.) on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated.

7. Members of the House of Commons are not precluded from tendering for these Bills.

8. Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Chief Cashier's Office, Bank of England.

9. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right of rejecting any Tenders.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under sections 9 and 13 of, and Schedule 5, to the Import Duties Act, 1958, and section 2(5) of the Finance Act 1965, viz.:

The Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 9) Order 1965.

This Order:

(i) provides for the allowance of drawback of import duty on the exportation of

(a) imported fresh oranges, exported in the cases in which they were imported;

(b) a wider range of specified products of "improved" wood, within the meaning of Chapter 44 of the Customs Tariff 1959, manufactured from imported wooden veneer sheets;

(c) certain insulated copper strip or wire manufactured from certain imported artificial resins and imported linseed oil;

(d) certain lubricating oil additives and specified organic chemicals manufactured from specified imported acetone cyanohydrin; and

(e) certain zinc alloy ingots manufactured from certain imported zinc and exported on or before 3rd December 1968; and

(ii) reduces the rate of drawback of import duty on imported tomato purée or paste used in the manufacture for export of foodstuffs, canned or bottled in tomato sauce.

The Order comes into operation on the 1st December, 1965, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1965, No. 1985.

THE TRUNK ROAD (WHITLAND) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1965

The Secretary of State has made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday

in that length of the London—Fishguard Trunk Road (A.40) in the Parish of Whitland, known as West Street and Market Street, from a point 120 yards west of its junction with North Street to a point 348 yards east of its junction with St. Mary's Street.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
