FACTORIES ACT 1961

The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that on 26th November 1965, he made The Baking and Sausage Making (Christmas and New Year) Order 1965, under section 117 of the Factories Act 1961. This Order enables women, who have attained the age of eighteen, to be employed in England and Wales on the afternoons of Saturdays, 18th December 1965 and 1st January 1966, and on Sundays, 19th and 26th December 1965 and 2nd January 1966, in the manufacture of meat pies, sausages or cooked meats, or in the pre-packing of bacon; and on the afternoon of Saturday, 18th December 1965, and on Sundays, 12th and 19th December 1965, in the manufacture of bread or flour confectionery (including fruit pies but not biscuits).

The Order also enables women, who have attained the age of eighteen, to be employed in Scotland on the afternoons of Saturdays, 18th December 1965 and 1st January 1966, and on Sundays, 19th and 26th December 1965 and 2nd January 1966, in the manufacture of meat pies, sausages or cooked meats, or in the pre-packing of bacon; and on Sunday, 26th December 1965, in the manufacture of bread or flour confectionery (including fruit pies but not biscuits).

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1962

Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way

Borough of Chesterfield

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government in exercise of his powers under section 155 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over certain footpaths in the Borough and Rural District of Chesterfield shown coloured blue on the map hereinafter referred to between points A-B-C, B-D and E-F, and crossing the Sheepbridge Industrial Site in the vicinity of the Monkwood branch railway line, to the north-west of Brierley Wood and north of Barlow Brook.

Copies of the draft Order and of the map showing the land to which it refers may be inspected at the Town Hall, Chesterfield, during normal office hours.

Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing, and addressed to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, before 3rd March 1966. The grounds of objection should be stated in full.
