

COUNTY BOROUGH OF BOOTLE

The Bootle (Street Parking Places No. 4) Order, 1966

The Council of the County Borough of Bootle propose to make an Order under Section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and Subsection (2) of Section 11 of, and Subsection (1) of Section 16 of, the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to authorise the use of the undermentioned length of road as a parking place by such classes of vehicles, in such positions and during such hours as are specified in relation to such length in the Schedule set out below:

The Bootle (Traffic Regulation No. 2) Order, 1966

The Council of the County Borough of Bootle propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

(a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the following lengths of road:

Oriel Road—East Side

From the north kerb line of Balliol Road for a distance of 45 feet in a northerly direction.

From the south kerb line of Trinity Road for a distance of 38 feet in a southerly direction.

From the north kerb line of Trinity Road for a distance of 45 feet in a northerly direction.

From the south kerb line of St. Edmond's Road for a distance of 45 feet in a southerly direction.

From the north kerb line of St. Edmond's Road for a distance of 45 feet in a northerly direction.

From the south kerb line of St. Catherine's Road for a distance of 45 feet in a southerly direction.

From the north kerb line of St. Catherine's Road for a distance of 45 feet in a northerly direction.

Oriel Road—West Side

From the north kerb line of Miller's Bridge for a distance of 45 feet in a northerly direction.

Müller's Bridge—North Side

From the west kerb line of Oriel Road for a distance of 45 feet in a westerly direction.

Miller's Bridge—South Side

From the west kerb line of King's Road for a distance of 45 feet in a westerly direction.

Balliol Road—North Side

From the east kerb line of Oriel Road for a distance of 80 feet in an easterly direction.

King's Road—West Side

From the south kerb line of Miller's Bridge for a distance of 45 feet in a southerly direction.

King's Road—East Side

From the south kerb line of Balliol Road for a distance of 45 feet in a southerly direction.

St. Catherine's Road—North Side

From the east kerb line of Oriel Road for a distance of 45 feet in an easterly direction.

From the west kerb line of Pembroke Road for a distance of 45 feet in a westerly direction.

St. Catherine's Road—South Side
From the east kerb line of Oriel Road for a distance of 150 feet in an easterly direction.

From the west kerb line of Pembroke Road for a distance of 45 feet in a westerly direction.

St. Edmond's Road—North Side

From the east kerb line of Oriel Road for a distance of 45 feet in an easterly direction.

From the west kerb line of Pembroke Road for a distance of 45 feet in a westerly direction.

Pembroke Road—West Side

From the south kerb line of St. Edmond's Road for a distance of 45 feet in a southerly direction.

(b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on every day except Sunday on the following lengths of road:

Oriel Road—East Side

From 45 feet north of the north kerb line of Balliol Road for a distance of 257 feet in a northerly direction.

From a point 45 feet north of the north kerb line of Trinity Road to a point 45 feet south of the south kerb line of St. Edmond's Road.

Oriel Road—West Side

From 45 feet south of the south kerb line of Trinity Road (produced) to 45 feet north of the north kerb line of St. Catherine's Road (produced).

Exceptions will be provided in the Order for boarding or alighting from vehicles, for loading or unloading, and for building operations, road maintenance and repairs or other similar work.

A copy of the proposed Order and of the map indicating the lengths of road affected thereby are available for inspection at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours.

The Bootle (Netherton Way) (Prohibition of Right-hand Turn) Traffic Regulation Order, 1966
