PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

ALDRIDGE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

Aldridge Urban District Council Clean Air Act, 1956

The Aldridge Urban District (Cottage Farm Estate) No. 26 Smoke Control Order 1966

Notice is hereby given by the Aldridge Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 22nd day of February 1966, made an Order titled "the Aldridge Urban District (Cottage Farm Estate) No. 26 Smoke Control Order, 1966", declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to limitations and exemptions provided by the Order by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act upon any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from the chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building will be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council House, Aldridge, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 11th day of March 1966.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL
