GREATER LONDON COUNCIL

A Traffic Management Order entitled *The Ealing (Prescribed Routes) (No. 2) Traffic Order 1966 (G.L.C. 1966 No. 60)* has been made by the Greater London Council. This Order, which came into operation on 7th May 1966:

- (1) makes permanent a system of experimental traffic control in part of the London Borough of Ealing;
- (2) imposes one-way traffic working and prohibits right turns in specified roads;
- (3) prohibits a specified right turn but exempts buses;
- (4) prohibits the passage of vehicles from east to west of a specified point in Rosebank Way;
- (5) prohibits U-turns through specified gaps in the central reservation of Western Avenue.
