- (c) outside the periods between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday's to Fridays inclusive or any time on Saturdays in any of the lengths or parts of a road specified in Schedule 3 hereto;
- (d) outside the periods between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive or at any time on Saturdays or Sundays in any of the lengths or parts of a road specified in Schedule 4 hereto;
- (e) between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive or between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Saturdays in any of the lengths or parts of a road specified in Schedule 5 hereto;
- (f) for a longer period than one hour in any period of four hours between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive or between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Saturdays in any of the lengths
- or parts of a road specified in Schedule 6 hereto; (g) for a longer period than two hours in any period of four hours between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive or between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Saturdays in any of the lengths or parts of a road specified in Schedule 7 hereto;
- (h) on alternate days or for a longer period than one hour in any period of four hours or other days between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive or between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Saturdays in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 8 hereto ;
- (i) on alternate days or for a longer period than two hours in any period of four hours on other days between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive or between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Saturdays in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 9 hereto.

2. To provide exceptions to as to enable a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths or parts of a road specified in Schedules 1 to 6 inclusive hereto

- (a) upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform;
 (b) for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage. Provided that except where the said person
- thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage. Provided that except where the said person is a disabled person no vehicle may so wait in the same place for longer than two minutes; (c) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to any of the said lengths or parts of a road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in any of the said lengths or parts of a road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths or parts of a road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to any of the said lengths or parts of a road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line or traffic sign: sign ;
- (d) if the vehicle is a vehicle used for fire brigade purposes or an ambulance, or any vehicle in the service of a local authority or police force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accident;
 (f) if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Postmaster General and is waiting while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to that length or part of a road are being unloaded from the vehicle, or having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to that length or part of a road; or is in use in connection with the servicing of telephone kiosks adjacent to that length or part of a road;
 (g) for so long as may be precessary to enable the vehicle to take in petrol oil water or air from any
- (g) for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths or parts of a road;
 (h) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository, or to such premises from a depository provided that notice is given 24 hours in advance to the police and their consent is obtained.

3. To provide additional exceptions so as to enable a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths or parts of 3. To provide additional exceptions so as to enable a venicle to wait in any of the fenguis of parts of a road specified in Schedules 3 to 9 inclusive hereto for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading a vehicle at premises adjoining that length or part of the road provided that no such vehicle shall so wait in the same place for a period of more than 30 minutes or such longer period as a police constable in uniform may authorise and shall not wait again on that length of part of road if a period of one hour has not elapsed since the termination of the lest period of waiting last period of waiting.

4. To provide for the revocation or amendment of existing Traffic Regulation Orders of the Council to such extent as may be necessary to enable effect to be given to the proposed Order. A copy of the proposed Order and plans showing the lengths or parts of roads involved, may be inspected between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, at the offices of the City Engineer's Traffic Engineering Section at Mappin Buildings, Norfolk Street, Sheffield 1. Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned within 28 days from the date

hereof.
