## LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

*Lincolnshire River Authority**Variation of the Metheringham and Dunston Award*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has now confirmed the Lincolnshire River Authority (Variation of Metheringham and Dunston Award) Order 1966 (S.I. 1966/793) made on 13th May 1966, confirming the Scheme submitted by the Lincolnshire River Authority under section 8 (1) of the Land Drainage Act 1930 for varying the land drainage provisions of the Metheringham and Dunston Award.

A copy of the Order may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Lincolnshire River Authority, 50, Wide Bargate, Boston, Lincs, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the Land Drainage Act 1930, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
