

**THE WEST SHROPSHIRE WATER BOARD

Notice is hereby given that the West Shropshire Water Board are about to apply to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for an Order under sections 9 and 50 of the Water Act, 1945.

The general effect of the Order will permit the Board to set apart in any year out of revenue such sums as they think fit to form and maintain a renewal fund for the purpose of defraying the cost of renewing vehicles and plant and other appliances forming part of the undertaking.

5. 12,700,000 gallons per year at Map Reference 07136412 in the aforementioned Parish.

6. 12,700,000 gallons per year at Map Reference 07436480 in the aforementioned Parish;
7. 1,200,000 gallons per year at Map Reference 09076369 in the aforementioned Parish;
8. 1,200,000 gallons per year at Map Reference 06196463 in the aforementioned Parish.
