HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (East of Bwlch Cottage Side Roads) Order 1966

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that in relation to the above mentioned Trunk Road and to a new length of trunk road which he proposes to construct east of Bwlch Cottage in the county of Montgomery, he has made under section 9 of the above Act an Order which will:—

(a) authorise the Secretary of State

(i) to stop up a length of the existing Trunk Road, and

(ii) to construct a new highway to connect the Garth—Heilyn—Bwlch Class III road with the new length of trunk road, east of Bwlch Cottage aforesaid, and

(b) provide for the transfer of the said highway to the County Council of Montgomery as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Welsh Office, Roads Division, ocen deposited at the Weish Office, Roads Division, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff, where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours. Certified copies have also been deposited at the offices of the County Council of Montgomery, County Offices, Welshpool where they are similarly open to inspection.

Copies of the Order, the title of which is "The Swansea—Manchester Trunk Road (East of Bwlch Cottage Side Roads) Order 1966" can be obtained from the Welsh Office, Roads Division, Graham Build-

ings, Newport Road, Cardiff.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with a relation to the Order may within all water from in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from 15th July 1966, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
