HARBOURS ACT, 1964

South Killingholme Jetty Empowerment Order

Notice is hereby given that the National Coal Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") has applied to the Minister of Transport to make a Harbour Empowerment Order under section 16 of the Harbours Act, 1964.

The objects of the proposed Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") are:

1. To authorise the Board to make, maintain, extend, enlarge, alter and replace the following works (hereinafter referred to as "the works") in the County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey and partly in the Parishes of South Killingholme in the Rural District of Glandford Brigg and of Immingham in the Rural District of Grimsby, and partly on the foreshore and bed of the River Humber:

Work No. 1

A jetty approach of open work construction with roadways, commencing at a point 27 yards south-south-east of a point on the bank of the River Humber 1,315 yards south-east of Killingholme South Low Lighthouse and extending in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 407 yards and there terminating;

Work No. 2

A jetty head of open work construction with berthing heads, strong points and mooring dolphins, connected by roadways, walkways and pipeways, commencing at a point 10 yards north of the termination of the jetty approach (Work No. 1), having a junction with the said jetty approach at the termination thereof, and extending in an east-south-easterly direction for a distance of 690 yards and there terminating.

2. To authorise the Board to construct or place and maintain subsidiary works in connection with
