SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Heddon-on-the-Wall in the Rural District of Castle Ward

Section of existing highway to be diverted

(1) *County Unclassified Road U.9096*

From its junction with Mill Lane (U.9040) in a northerly and westerly direction for a distance of approximately 534 yards to its junction with the highway known as Bridle Road No. 2.

(2) *Bridle Road No. 2*

From a point approximately 75 yards east of its junction with the highway known as Footpath No. 1 in an easterly direction to its junction with highway U.9096.

(3) *Footpath No. 3*

From its junction with Mill Lane in a north-westerly and then north-easterly direction to its junction with highway U.9096.

(4) *Footpath No. 4*

From a point approximately 75 yards south of the point at which it crosses Dewley Burn in a south-westerly direction to its junction with the highway U.9096.

Alongside and parallel to the proposed diverted section of highway U.9096.

From a point approximately 75 yards south of the point at which it crosses Dewley Burn in a south-easterly direction to join Mill Lane at a point approximately 100 yards east of the junction of Mill Lane with highway U.9096.
