### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1960

#### *The Trunk Road (High Street, Honiton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1966*

The Minister of Transport proposes to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to impose waiting restrictions in that length of the London-Penzance Trunk Road (A.30) known as High Street, in the Borough of Honiton, between a point 76 yards south-west of its junction with Northcote Lane and a point 76 yards north-east of its junction with New Street.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

Objections to the Order must be sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, by 30th August 1966, quoting the reference GT 3/8/031, and stating the full reasons for objection.

### PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS, 1937 AND 1948

#### *Switzerland*
