HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The South of Quinton—Great Barr Special Roads (Side Roads No. 2) Order, 1966

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that she has made an Order under section 13 of the above Act, in relation to the parts of the South of Quinton—Great Barr Special Road which will be situated in the County Boroughs of West Bromwich, and Warley, which will—

(a) authorise the Minister—

(i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter a highway;

(ii) to stop up a highway;

(iii) to construct a new highway;

(iv) to stop up private means of access to premises; and
