The Waltham Holy Cross Urban District Council
(No. 1) *Smoke Control Area* 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Waltham Holy Cross Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 4th day of October 1966, made an Order entitled the Waltham Holy Cross Urban District Council (No. 1) Smoke Control Order, 1966, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of August 1967, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order (and of the map referred to therein) may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Waltham Abbey, Essex, and at the Public Health Department, 6 Highbridge Street, Waltham Abbey, Essex, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 11th day of November 1966.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area will extend over all premises and lands bounded by a line drawn in the centre of Farm Hill Road from number 16 Farm Hill Road to its junction with Honey Lane; in the centre of Honey Lane from its junction with Farm Hill Road to the boundary of number 28 Honey Lane; on the north-east, eastern and south-west boundaries of the Phase I of the Urban District Council's Honey Lane Housing Site on the south-east and south-west boundaries of the Honey Lane Nurseries development; on the south and west boundaries of Pan Britannica Industries Limited; and on the west boundary of the Joyce Court development to number 16 Farm Hill Road.
