BATH CITY COUNCIL

*The City of Bath (Abbey Street and Stall Street) (Restrictions on Driving) Order 1966*

Notice is hereby given that the Bath City Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed along, or any pedal bicycle or pedal tricycle to be ridden along, either of the following lengths of road, subject to exceptions in respect of vehicles being used in connection with building and the like operations; removing obstructions; road works; statutory undertakers' works; and fire brigades, ambulance or police purposes, namely:

*Abbey Street* from a line 24 feet south of the northern kerb-line of York Street, southwards for a distance of 101 feet.

*Stall Street* from a line 6 feet south of the projection of the southern kerb-line of Westgate Street, southwards for a distance of 162 feet.

BASINGSTOKE BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Basingstoke (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 7) Order, 1966*
