

SCHEDULE 2

Manor Road

(i) On the eastern side of Manor Road from the existing prohibition of waiting south of the junction with Cheriton Road to the existing prohibition of waiting north of the junction with Ingles Road.

(ii) On the eastern side of Manor Road from the existing prohibition on waiting south of the junction with Ingles Road to the existing prohibition on waiting north of the junction with Bouverie Road West.

The Stade—From the end of the existing order in an easterly and northerly direction for 170 feet.

Beach Street (South Side)—From railway arch for a distance of 200 feet in a westerly direction.

*The Borough of Folkestone (Traffic Regulation)
(Various Roads) (No. 4) Order, 1966*

The Folkestone Borough Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which with certain exceptions will be to prohibit waiting of vehicles as follows:

1. At all times in the parts of roads specified in the First Schedule for a distance of 25 feet from the junction with the trunk road.
2. At all times in the parts of roads specified in the Second Schedule for varying distances from the junction with the trunk road.
