Where a heading of the Convention on Nomenclature for the Classification of Goods in Customs Tariffs (Cmnd. 1070) (commonly known as the Brussels Nomenclature) is specified in relation to any class of goods that class does not comprise goods which do not fall within the heading specified, having regard to the

rules and notes for the interpretation of the Nomenclature.

The description of any goods in the first column of the List shall be taken to include cases, boxes and similar containers normally sold therewith if such containers (being imported with the goods) would fall within the heading of the Brussels Nomenclature specified.

DISEASES OF FISH ACT, 1937
