ATHERTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Atherton Urban District Council (No. 3) Smoke Control Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Atherton in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 9th day of November 1966, made an

Order entitled the Atherton Urban District Council (No. 3) Smoke Control Order, 1966, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the first day of November 1967, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Atherton, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 10th day of November 1966.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may be notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

An area containing in the whole 352 acres or thereabouts bounded on its several sides by the following:

On the east side from the centre of Market Street at its junction with Bullough Street in a northerly direction on a line to the rear of the odd numbered properties on Bag Lane to Derby Street continuing north by north-east on the westerly side of Derby Street to Car Bank Street.

On the north side along the southerly side of Car Bank Street (even numbered, 166 to 230) to the mineral railway as a boundary and thence continue along the mineral railway in a northerly direction to the Urban District boundary; from this point on the Urban District boundary continue in a westerly and southerly direction to Schofield Lane and thence to junction of Schofield Lane with Colliery Lane.
