HITCHIN RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

Hitchin Rural District Council (Footpath No. 2, Parish of Holwell) Public Path Diversion Order, 1966.

Notice is hereby given that the above Order, made on the 3rd day of November 1966, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The effect of the Order is to divert that part of the public right of way which commences at the southern end of the path, on the west side of the ditch along the eastern boundary of the property known as "Gurneys", in the Parish of Holwell, and runs generally north for a distance of approximately 200 yards, to a route on the eastern side of the afore-mentioned ditch running generally north for a distance of approximately 77 yards where it crosses the ditch via a footbridge to join Footpath No. 3, and then continues from the eastern side of the footbridge generally north for a distance of approximately 123 yards.

A copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Council Offices, Grammar School Walk, Hitchin, and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. to 12.45 p.m., and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m., on weekdays (Saturdays, 9 a.m. to 12 noon).

LICHFIELD CITY COUNCIL

Lichfield City Council Footpath Number 22 Public Path Diversion Order, 1966
