- 4. Permit the parking of vehicles at designated street parking places between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, free of charge and without time limit in certain parts of the streets named in the Sixth Schedule hereto.
