

with Tower Ramparts except the 10 yards "No Waiting" area opposite the cellar flap of the Hotel.

11. St. Helen's Street
 - (a) The north side—the frontages of the County Hotel and the National Deposit Friendly Society.
 - (b) The south side between a point 45 yards east of its junction with Rope Walk and a point 8 yards west of the centre of the Petrol Filling Station adjoining No. 168 St. Helen's Street.
 - (c) The south side between a point 8 yards east of the centre of the Petrol Filling Station adjoining No. 168 St. Helen's Street and a point 45 yards west of its junction with Grove Lane.
12. Soane Street. The south side between its junction with St. Margaret's Plain and a point 95 yards east of that junction.
13. Tower Ramparts. The north side between a point 38 yards east of its junction with High Street and a point 8 yards west of its junction with Peel Street, except the two factory access ways of 7 yards and 8 yards.
14. Woodbridge Road. The lay-bys situated between its junction with Cauldwell Hall Road and its junction with Woodbridge Road East and Spring Road.

THE THIRD SCHEDULE—PART II

In the County Borough of Ipswich:

1. Berners Street. The west side between its junction with Bedford Street and a point 90 yards north of that junction, except the entrances to Nos. 37, 39, 41 and 43 Berners Street.
2. Christchurch Street. The east side between a point 12 yards north of its junction with Woodbridge Road and a point 12 yards south of its junction with Cemetery Road.
3. Cobbold Street. The north side between a point 45 yards east of its junction with St. Margaret's Green and a point 50 yards west of its junction with Christchurch Street.
4. Fonnereau Road
 - (a) The east side between a point 43 yards north of its junction with St. Margaret's Plain and a point 16 yards south of its junction with Bridle Way.
 - (b) The east side between a point 3 yards north of its junction with Bridle Way and a point 50 yards south of its junction with Henley Road except the entrances to Nos. 8, 10, 18, 20 and 22 Fonnereau Road.
5. Lower Brook Street. The west side between a point 43 yards south of its junction with Dog's Head Street and a point 5 yards north of its junction with Turret Lane.

In the County Borough of Ipswich:

1. Berners Street. The west side between a point 90 yards north of its junction with Bedford Street and a point 7 yards south of its junction with Anglesea Road, except the entrances to Nos. 49 and 89 Berners Street.

1. Butter Market
 - (a) The north side between its junction with The Thoroughfare and a point 48 yards west of that junction.
 - (b) The north side between its junction with The Thoroughfare and a point 12 yards west of its junction with Dial Lane.
 - (c) The north side between its junction with Dial Lane and a point 5 yards west of its junction with St. Lawrence Street.
 - (d) The north side between its junction with St. Lawrence Street and a point 8 yards west of its junction with Upper Brook Street.

2. Museum Street

- (a) The east side between a point 5 yards south of its junction with Westgate Street and a point 5 yards north of the centre of the access way adjoining No. 3A Museum Street.
 - (b) The east side between a point 5 yards south of the centre of the access way adjoining No. 3A Museum Street and a point 5 yards north of the centre of the access way situated between Nos. 11 and 13 Museum Street.
 - (c) The east side between a point 4 yards south of its junction with Elm Street and a point 7 yards north of its junction with Princes Street.
3. Peel Street. The west side between a point 2 yards south of its junction with Crown Street and a point 2 yards north of its junction with Tower Ramparts.
 4. Princes Street
 - (a) The south-east side between a point 32 yards south-west of its junction with Thursby's Lane and a point 5 yards south-west of that junction.
 - (b) The south-east side between a point 4 yards north-east of its junction with Coytes Gardens and a point 37 yards north-east of that junction.
 5. Queen Street. The west side between a point 13 yards north of its junction with Friars Street and a point 47 yards north of that junction.

6. St. Peter's Street

- (a) The east side between its junction with Silent Street and a point 2 yards north of its junction with Rose Lane.
- (b) The east side between a point 2 yards south of its junction with Rose Lane and a point 62 yards north of its junction with College Street.

7. Tavern Street

- (a) The south side between a point 20 yards east of its junction with the Cornhill and a point 30 yards west of its junction with Dial Lane.
- (b) The south side between a point 17 yards west of its junction with St. Lawrence Street and a point 2 yards west of that junction.
- (c) The south side between a point 2 yards east of its junction with St. Lawrence Street and a point 39 yards west of its junction with Upper Brook Street.

8. Westgate Street

- (a) The south side between a point 3 yards east of its junction with Black Horse Lane and a point 7 yards west of its junction with Museum Street.
- (b) The south side between a point 10 yards east of its junction with Museum Street and a point 38 yards west of its junction with the Cornhill, except the bus stop near its junction with Providence Street.

In the County Borough of Ipswich:

Rope Walk

- (a) The south side between a point 45 yards east of its junction with Waterworks Street and a point 5 yards west of the centre of the entrance to Woodhouse Square.
- (b) The south side between a point 41 yards west of its junction with Grimwade Street and a point 5 yards east of the centre of the entrance to Woodhouse Square.

THE FIFTH SCHEDULE—PART I

In the County Borough of Ipswich:

1. Argyle Street. Between its junction with St. Helen's Street and a point 20 yards north of that junction.
2. Berners Street. Between its junction with St. Matthew's Street and its junction with Bedford Street.
3. Bramford Road. Between a point 20 yards north-west of its junction with Yarmouth Road and a point 20 yards north of that junction.
4. Bridge Street. Between its junction with College Street and a point 20 yards south of that junction.
5. Butter Market. The south side between the east side of its junction with St. Lawrence Street and a point 15 yards west of that junction.
