- 2. To empower the Board and their subsidiary British Rail Hovercraft Limited to provide hover-craft services for the carriage of goods and passengers in addition to the services authorised by the Railway Shipping Acts
- 3. To extend, at the Board's harbours, the powers of harbour masters as authorised by the Harbours Docks and Piers Clauses Act, 1847, and the powers of the Board relating to the leasing and granting of interests in harbour property, the berthing of vessels, the enforcement and recovery

of charges in respect of vessels and goods; and to make special provisions as to dangerous goods entering the Board's harbours and the safety of goods deposited thereat.
