The City Council of Liverpool (Off-Street Parking Places) (No. 3) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th November 1966, the Liverpool City Council made an Order under Section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and Sub-section 11 of the Road Traffic-Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which is to authorise and regulate the use of the car parks specified in the Schedule hereto. The Order, which came into effect on the 1st December 1966, also provides for the revocation of the City of Liverpool (Off-Street Parking Places) (No. 2) Order, 1965.

SOUTHEND-ON-SEA COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

County Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Various Streets) (One-Way) (No. 6) Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that on the 19th December 1966, the Southend-on-Sea County Borough Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is—

(a) To introduce one-way traffic working as shown in the following roads—

Length of Road	Direction of Permitted Movement
London Road from its eastern extremity to its junction with Boston Avenue.	Westbound.
Victoria Avenue from a point 90 yards north of the north kerb line of London Road (the junction with Broadway Market) to its southern extremity.	Southbound.

(b) To repeal the existing Order effecting one-way traffic in (i) Warrior Square between Warrior Square West and High Street and (ii) Warrior Square West.

(c) To repeal so much of the existing Order as prohibits the driving of vehicles eastwards in Queens Road between Elmer Place and High Street.
