CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

CARLTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Carlton No. 2 Smoke Control Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Carlton Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 25th day of January 1967 made an Order entitled the Carlton No. 2 Smoke Control Order 1967, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order (and of the map referred to therein) may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Carlton Urban District Council, Burton Road, Carlton, Nottingham, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 10th February 1967.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The Carlton No. 2 Smoke Control Order relates to an area of 68.46 acres or thereabouts, the boundaries of which are as follows:

1. The northern side of Carlton Hill in a westerly direction from Foxhill Road to First Avenue.
2. The eastern and south-eastern side of First Avenue.
3. The south-western side of Foxhill Road in a south-easterly direction from First Avenue to Carlton Hill.

The Greetland (No. 2) Smoke Control Order, 1966

Notice is hereby given that Elland Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 28th day of December 1966, made The Greetland (No. 2) Smoke Control Order, 1966 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order has been submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any date after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before 1st July, 1968, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Clerk of the Council, Council Offices, Elland, at all reasonable time during the period of six weeks from the 8th day of February 1967.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

The area comprising the whole of Greetland Ward of the urban district, excluding the area of the Greetland (No. 1) Smoke Control Order, 1963.

EXETER CITY COUNCIL

City of Exeter (Whipton No. 1) Smoke Control Order 1967

City of Exeter (Carlyon Gardens) Smoke Control Order 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Exeter City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 30th day of January 1967 made the following Orders:

(1) "The City of Exeter (Whipton No. 1) Smoke Control Order 1967" declaring the area described in the First Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, and

(2) "The City of Exeter (Carlyon Gardens) Smoke Control Order 1967" declaring the area described in the Second Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which said Orders have been submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Orders and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Orders have come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Areas the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Orders will not come into operation before the 1st day of September 1967 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of each of the Orders and of the maps referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at my office, 10 Southernhay West, Exeter, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 7th day of February 1967.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by either of the Orders may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

FIRST SCHEDULE

An area containing approximately 15 acres bounded on the north side by part of Pinhoe Road, on the east side by part of Vaughan Road, Hill Lane and a tributary of Heavitree Brook, on the south side by part of Thornpark Rise and on the west side by part of Vaughan Road and Hill Lane all which area of land is delineated on the map referred to above and thereon coloured green.

SECOND SCHEDULE

An area containing approximately 6 acres bounded on the north side by Heavitree Brook, on the east side by the rear of Madison Avenue, on the south side by Sweetbrier Lane and on the west side by the rear of Hamlin Gardens all which area of land is delineated on the map referred to above and thereon coloured green.
