

SOUTHEND-ON-SEA COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

County Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting and One-Way) Orders, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Southend-on-Sea propose to make Orders under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

(a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles as follows:

<i>Length of Road</i>	<i>Side of Road</i>	<i>Hours of Prohibition</i>
Hamstel Road from its junction with Southchurch Road to a point 10 yards north of its junction with Glenmore Street.	Both.	24 hours daily.
Glenmore Street from its junction with Hamstel Road westwards for a distance of 10 yards.	Both.	24 hours daily.
Belton Way East from its junction with Belton Way West eastwards to a point 10 yards east of the junction of Belton Gardens with Belton Way East.	South.	24 hours daily.
Church Hill from its junction with Leigh Hill northwards for a distance of 40 yards.	Both.	24 hours daily.
Eastwood Road North from its junction with The Fairway north-eastwards for a distance of 10 yards.	North-west.	24 hours daily.
Eastwood Road North from a point 24 yards north-east from the western boundary of the "Woodcutters Arms" Public House north-eastwards to its junction with Wood Farm Close.	North-west.	24 hours daily.

Exceptions will be provided in the above Orders to enable a vehicle to wait for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of furniture or of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

(b) To prohibit the driving of vehicles in the following roads otherwise than in the direction indicated:

<i>Length of Road</i>	<i>Direction of Permitted Movement</i>
Hainault Avenue from Westborough Road to Fairfax Drive	Northwards.
Glenwood Avenue from Westborough Road to Fairfax Drive	Southwards.

WORCESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Worcester (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No. 2) Order, 1966.

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th day of February 1967, the Worcester City Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

- To revoke the City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 6) Order, 1963, in so far as it relates to restricted waiting in the Bull Ring.
- To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto subject to the usual exceptions.
- To prohibit the loading and unloading of goods from vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. in those streets listed in the Second and Third Schedules to the City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 6) Order, 1963.

THE SCHEDULE

(i) The south side of the Bull Ring from its junction with Bromwich Lane for a distance of 100 feet in a westerly direction.

(ii) Both sides of Bromyard Road from its junction with St. John's to its junction with Church Terrace in a westerly direction.

WORCESTER CITY COUNCIL

City of Worcester (St. John's) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No. 5) Order 1966

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th day of February 1967 the Worcester City Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is:

- To revoke that part of the City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 6) Order 1963 insofar as it relates to restricted waiting on the north side of St. John's.

2. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. To prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. in the length of road specified in the Schedule subject to exceptions in favour of Post Office vehicles and furniture removal vans.

SCHEDULE

The north side of St. John's from a point 20 feet west of Henwick Road for a distance of 60 feet in a westerly direction.
