THE SCHEDULE

1. *The East of Christchurch-Tredegar Park Trunk Road Order, 1948 (S.I. 1948/62)*

A section of the M.4 Motorway at Newport in the county of Monmouth consisting of a length of the new road (a trunk road to which by virtue of section 19 of the Highways Act, 1959, the provisions of that Act apply as if it were a special road) provided by the Secretary of State in pursuance of the above-mentioned Order along a part of the route described in the First Schedule to that Order, being a length

which begins at the junction of that route with the routes of the two western connecting roads to the Malpas Road roundabout (see paragraph 2 (ii) below) and ends at the termination point of that route (a point on the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A.48) on the west side of Tredegar Park at its junction with the road leading to Bassaleg).

2. *The East of Christchurch-Tredegar Park Motorway Connecting Roads Special Roads Scheme (S.I. 1965/1247).*

The following special roads provided by the Secretary of State at Newport in the county of Monmouth in pursuance of the above-mentioned Scheme:

- (i) the special roads forming the connecting roads to the Glaslwich Crescent roundabout (A.467) along the routes described in paragraph 1 (2) of the Schedule to that Scheme; and
- (ii) the special roads forming the two western connecting roads to the Malpas Road roundabout along the routes described in paragraph 2.2 (c) and (d) of the Schedule to that Scheme.
