NORTH WEST GLOUCESTERSHIRE WATER BOARD

Application for confirmation of Water Byelaws

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS.
