ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

ROYAL COUNTY OF BERKSHIRE

(Bracknell) (No Waiting) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which shall be to prohibit vehicles from waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of road which are at present subject to an "Experimental" Order and specified in the Schedule to this notice.

WORCESTER CITY COUNCIL

City of Worcester (Public Hall Site) Parking Place Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Worcester City Council have made an Order under Section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and section 11 (2) of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

(a) To prohibit the parking of any vehicle on the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the parking place") other than a private motor car having a seating capacity not exceeding 12 persons excluding the driver or a motor cycle with or without a side car.

(b) To prohibit any person repairing a vehicle on the parking place except to enable the driver to leave the parking place.

(c) To exempt the said Council from any liability for loss or damage to any vehicle at the parking place or anything contained therein or thereon.

(d) To authorise a charge of 1s. for each two hours or part thereof, subject to a maximum charge of 5s. for one continuous period of waiting.
