### WATER RESOURCES ACT 1963

## Sussex River Authority

In pursuance of section 11 (6) (a) of the Water Resources Act 1963, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food hereby gives notice that the Sussex River Authority have made an application for the variation of the main river map of their area.

Short descriptions of the proposals are set out below. The effect will be to bring the added water-courses under the Sussex River Authority's jurisdiction for land drainage and flood prevention purposes; watercourses deleted will be freed from this jurisdiction.

Additions

1. Part of Harting Brook near Nyewood.

2. Part of Scrase Bridge Stream, being a new length of channel at Haywards Heath.

3. Part of River Ouse, being a new cut by Waps-bourne Wood near Sheffield Park Railway Station.

4. A short length of Chess Stream by Blackstone Lane near Blackstone.

5. Part of Hanging Camp Stream near Berwick.

6. Part of Mill Stream, a short length of watercourse west of Herstmonceux.

7. A diversion of the Whelpley Sewer near New Bridge, west of Herstmonceux, consisting of an

existing unnamed watercourse, two new cuts still to be made and part of Puckeridge Sewer. The diver-sion will be siphoned under Hurst Haven.

8. Part of Knock Hatch Stream west of Hailsham. 9. A new cut which will form part of Waller's Haven, near Normans' Bay, Bexhill.

10. A short length of watercourse immediately east of St. Anne's Road, Willingdon.

11. A disused canal on the River Rother near Lods Bridge, near Selham.

12. A disused loop of the River Rother by South Copse, near Selham.

13. The channel made redundant by Item 2.

14. The channel made redundant by Item 3.

15. The channel made redundant by Item 6.

16. The channel made redundant by Item 7.
