### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1962 MINERAL WORKINGS ACT 1951

#### *Bedford*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that she has made an Order under sections 153 and 217 (3) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962 and section 32 of the Mineral Workings Act 1951 entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Bedford) (No. 5) Order 1959 Revocation and the Diversion of Highways (County of Bedford) (No. 2) Order 1967" authorising the temporary diversion for a period of 15 years of a length of footpath off Reach Lane, Heath and Reach, and requiring the provision of a temporary new footpath and the restoration of the old footpath at the end of this period.

#### *Brindle, Lancs*
