

HYDE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Hyde (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Hyde Borough Council propose to make an Order under subsections (1) (2) and (3) of Section 26 and subsection (4) of Section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to provide that no person except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform shall cause or permit the waiting of a vehicle (other than to enable persons to board or leave the vehicle, goods to be loaded or unloaded or the vehicle to be used in connection with funeral or building operations) in the lengths of road described in Part I of the Schedule below, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, and at any time in the length of road specified in Part II of the Schedule.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 23rd June 1967.

The Borough of Keighley (Devonshire Street) (Restriction of Waiting) Order No. 2, 1967

Notice is hereby given that a public inquiry will be held by E. C.
