Proposed amendment to The Parking Places (Camden) Order 1966

(3) the standard period for which a vehicle may be left in these parking places will be

(b) 2 hours in the additional bays in the parking places numbered 60 and 70 in the First Schedule to the Order of 1966, which bays are in Pakenham Street and Wren Street

(c) subject to the above, for an unlimited period in any one day in the remaining part of Britannia Street and the other streets to which this Order refers.

this Order refers; (4) the standard period for which a vehicle may be left in parking place No. 36 of the Order of 1966, which is in Frederick Street, is extended from 2 hours to an unlimited period in any one day:

(5) new motor cycle parking places are designated in Britannia Street and Leeke Street;

(6) to apply to the new parking places the provisions of the Order of 1966 so as in particular

(i) fix the maximum number of parking bays: (i.e. spaces on the carriageway where vehicles may be left) in each parking place; to provide that the number and situation of such parking
