

2. an Order under section 9 of the above Act authorising the Secretary of State

(a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,

(b) to stop up highways,

(c) to construct new highways, all in relation to the proposed Carmarthen Diversion aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Carmarthen as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies that authority that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
