Notice is hereby given that on the 15th May 1967, the Hampshire County Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

- (a) to revoke The Hampshire (Alton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1964, in so far as it relates to the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (b) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. in either of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice;
- (c) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles for a longer period than 30 minutes in any hour, or if a period of less than 30 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any), between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. in either of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this notice;

(d) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the length of road specified in the Fourth Schedule to this notice.

The Order contains certain exemptions for the picking up and setting down of passengers and the loading and unloading of goods.
