THE TRUNK ROAD (PENTRE HALKYN) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State has made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is that no person shall cause any vehicle to enter the Bryn Alyn-Pentre Halkyn road (B.5123) from the Chester-Bangor Trunk Road (A.55) in the County of Flint.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1962

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 153 of the above Act entitled "The Diversion of Highways (County of Glamorgan) (No. 21) Order, 1967" authorising the diversion of two footpaths at Llansamlet, Swansea, and involving the provision of a new footpath.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of this Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 18th July 1967, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
