

From a point 16 yards north of the centre of its junction with George Street to a point 14 yards south of the centre of its junction with George Street.

From a point 16 yards north of the centre of its junction with Denmark Street to its junction with Vicarage Road.

Tavistock Street—both sides

From its junction with Victoria Road to a point 15 yards westwards.

Western Road—both sides

From its junction with Victoria Road to a point 15 yards westwards.

Church Street—north side

From its junction with Victoria Road to a point 17 yards eastwards. From its junction with Aylesbury Street to a point 15 yards westwards.

Church Street—south side

From its junction with Victoria Road to a point 17 yards eastwards.

From a point opposite the boundary wall between Nos. 28 and 30 Church Street to a point opposite the boundary wall between Nos. 36 and 38 Church Street.

From its junction with Aylesbury Street to a point 15 yards westwards.

George Street—both sides

From its junction with Victoria Road to a point 16 yards eastwards.

From its junction with Aylesbury Street to a point 17 yards eastwards of the boundary between Nos. 23 and 25 George Street.

From its junction with Victoria Road to a point 14 yards eastwards. From its junction with Aylesbury Street to a point 65 yards westwards.

Queensway and Vicarage Road B.4034—north side

From a point 3 yards west of the eastern boundary wall of the County Junior School to its junction with Aylesbury Street.

Queensway and Vicarage Road B.4034—south side

From a point 22 yards west of the eastern boundary wall of the County Junior School to its junction with Aylesbury Street.

Victoria Road—west side

From a point 17 yards south of the centre of its junction with Tavistock Street to a point 17 yards north of the centre of its junction with Western Road.

Victoria Road—east side

From a point 14 yards south of the centre of its junction with Church Street to a point 16 yards north of the centre of its junction with George Street.

From a point 14 yards south of the centre of its junction with George Street to a point 16 yards north of the centre of its junction with Denmark Street.

Church Street—north side

From a point 17 yards east of its junction with Victoria Road to a point 15 yards west of its junction with Aylesbury Street.

From a point 16 yards west of its junction with Aylesbury Street to a point 92 yards west of its junction with Aylesbury Street.

Denmark Street—south side

From a point 14 yards east of its junction with Victoria Road to a point 65 yards west of its junction with Aylesbury Street.

CAERNARVONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Caernarvon (Morfa Nefyn to Bryn Cynan Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Caernarvonshire County Council have made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960 the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the length of road in the Parish of Nefyn on the Morfa Nefyn to Bryn Cynan Road from a point 500 yards south east of the junction of roads B.4412 and B.4417 for a distance of 230 yards towards Bryn Cynan.

Exceptions are provided in the Order for loading and unloading vehicles, vehicles used in connection with building operations and highway maintenance and vehicles taking in petrol, oil, etc. from any garage on the said length of road.

The Order will come into effect on the 1st day of October 1967.

CAMBORNE-REDRUTH URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

(Trewirgie Road, Redruth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Camborne-Redruth Urban District Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive, in each week, in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereunder.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of the length of road or the services therein; to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with a funeral.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 7th October 1967.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan showing the length of road referred to in the Order, will be available for inspection during normal office hours at the Council Offices, Camborne.
