

PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS, 1937 AND 1948

Ethiopia

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice in pursuance of the above-named Regulations that he hereby recognises the Official Certificate of which particulars are given in the Schedule hereto as showing (a) that the meat from which the meat product to which the Certificate relates was prepared, was derived from animals inspected ante and post mortem and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister and (b) that all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to public health were taken in the preparation and packing of the meat product.

Where the Certificate is in the form of a label the recognition will apply only if the label is securely affixed to the package containing the meat product, and if the label has not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as an Official Certificate; and where the Certificate is in the form of a stamp, the recognition will apply only if the stamp is clearly impressed on the container.

The Certificate is in addition to that printed in the notice published in the *London Gazette* and dated 4th September 1964.

The certificate will be completed by the insertion of the number of the establishment, and by the impression of the veterinary officer's seal.
