At the Court at Balmoral, the 10th day of October 1967.

PRESENT,

The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas the Minister of Housing and Local Government, after giving to the Incumbent and Churchwardens of the Parish of Little Coates, near Grimsby, in the county of Lincoln, ten days' previous notice of his intention in that behalf, has, under the provisions of the Burial Act 1853, as amended by subsequent enactments made a Representation to Her Majesty in Council that, for the protection of the Public Health, burials should be discontinued forthwith and entirely in St. Michael's Churchyard in the said Parish, shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto.

Provided that, in the grave spaces reserved for the purpose the burial may be allowed at their

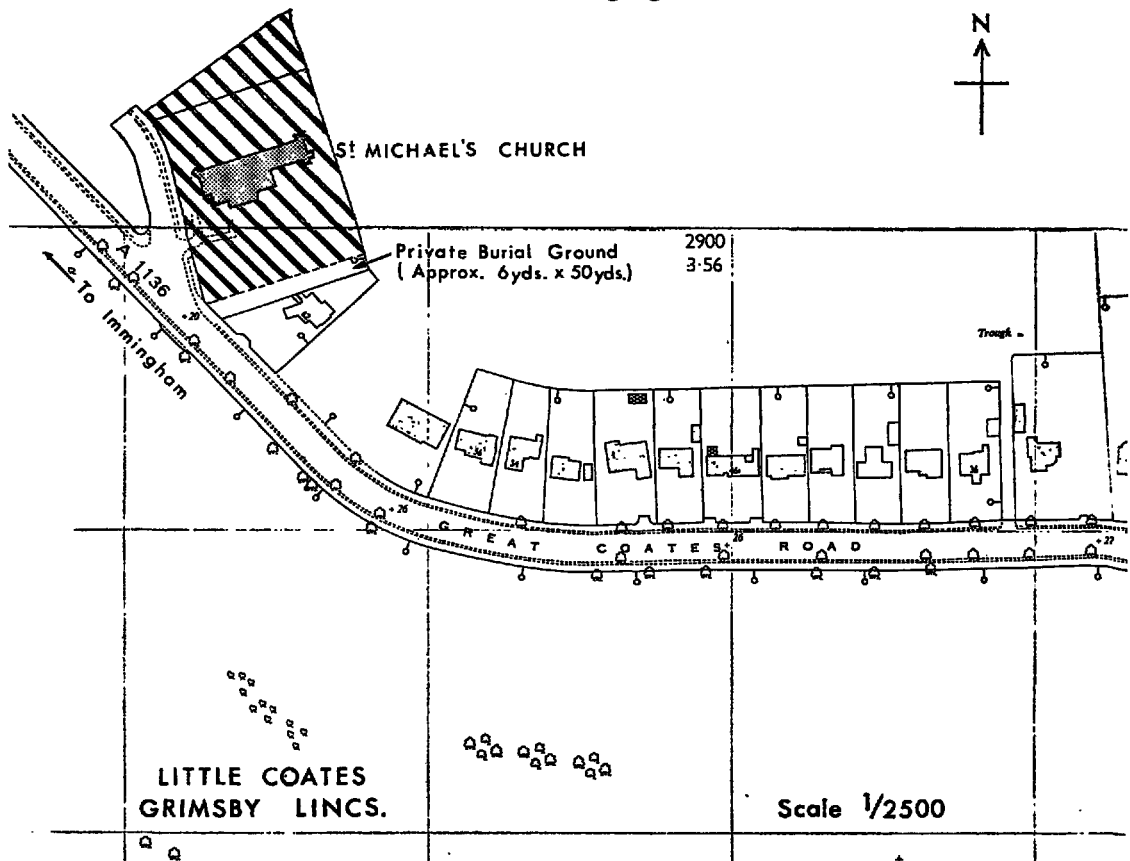
decease of the bodies of John Percy Hellewell, Alice Mary Hellewell, Wilfred Burgess, Emily May Burgess, Davine Rosamund Cliff Robinson and Fanny Jane Hunt, subject in each case to the condition that no part of the coffin containing the body shall be at a depth less than three feet below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave.

Now, therefore, Her Majesty in Council is pleased hereby to give notice of such Representation and to Order that the same be taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council on the 10th day of December next.

And Her Majesty is further pleased to direct that this Order be forthwith published in the *London Gazette*, and that copies thereof be affixed on the doors of the Churches or chapels of, or on some conspicuous places within, the Parish affected by such Representation one month before the said 10th day of December.
