REPORT OF THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

Prices of Fletton and Non-Fletton Bricks

On 24th May 1967, in pursuance of their powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and the Minister of Public Building and Works referred the question of Prices of Fletton and Non-Fletton Bricks to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination.

The Board has now made its report and in accordance with section 5 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966 the Secretary of State for Economic Affairs, and the Minister of Public Building and Works hereby give notice that the report was first published as Command Paper No. 3480 on 30th November 1967.
