

Dunning Road (east) between 94 feet and 82 feet north from Borough Road (parking allowed between 8 a.m. and 2 a.m.)

Wilson Street (south) between 157 feet west from Linthorpe Road and 140 feet east from Hill Street (the maximum waiting period to be 2 hours).

The side street (situate at the east end of Garden Street) between Bolckow Street and Vaughan Street (east side) } between 69 feet and 108 feet south from Bolckow Street (the maximum waiting period to be 2 hours).

The following existing parking places become restricted to a maximum waiting period of 2 hours

Corporation Road (north side) between 20 feet and 254 feet east from Gurney Street and between 279 feet and 415 feet east from Gurney Street.

Hartington Road (south-west) between 85 feet south-east from Newport Road and 20 feet north-west from Beaufort Street.

Head Street (east) between 20 feet south from Grange Road and 20 feet north from Monkland Street and between 20 feet south from Monkland Street and 20 feet north from Westward Street and between 20 feet south from Westward Street and 20 feet north from Birks Street and between 20 feet south from Birks Street and 20 feet north from Borough Road.

Hill Street (east) between 20 feet south from Wilson Street and 20 feet north from Bolckow Street and between 20 feet south from Bolckow Street and 20 feet north from Garden Street and between 20 feet south from Garden Street and 20 feet north from Vaughan Street and between 20 feet south from Vaughan Street and 20 feet north from Johnson Street.

King Edwards Road (south) between 20 feet east from Linthorpe Road and 20 feet west from Temple Street and between 20 feet east from Temple Street and 20 feet west from Eldon Road and between 20 feet east from Eldon Road and 35 feet west from east side of Albert Road.

The following area becomes a no-waiting area at any time.

Abingdon Road (east side) between Southfield Road and a point 205 feet to the north thereof.

The following become one way roads (the direction in which vehicles are to be driven being as indicated).

Diamond Road (between Borough Road and Garnet Street)—southward Dundas Mews—southward.
