**PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD)
REGULATIONS, 1937 AND 1948**

Norway

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice in pursuance of the above-named Regulations that his recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in Part II of the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 12th August 1938, for the importation of meat and meat products from Norway, is hereby modified to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 7th November 1967, is hereby revoked.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930

Snettisham Internal Drainage District

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4 (3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Great Ouse River Authority, under section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, making provision for the abrogation of the differential rating provisions of the North Norfolk Rivers Catchment Board (Snettisham Internal Drainage District) Order 1932 in respect of the area hatched purple on the map sealed in relation thereto.

The Scheme affects land in the Parishes of Heacham and Snettisham in the Rural District of Docking in the County of Norfolk.

DISEASES OF FISH ACT 1937

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has made the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) No. 1 Order 1968 (S.I. 1968 No.).
