

Day, Boxing Day, Easter Monday and Spring Bank Holiday Monday:

- (i) The south side of King Cross Road between Trafalgar Street and No. 197 King Cross Road.
- (ii) The south side of King Cross Road from No. 199 King Cross Road to No. 233A King Cross Road.
- (iii) The north side of King Cross Road between its junction with Queens Road and No. 184 King Cross Road.
- (iv) The carriageways at the junctions of King Cross Road with Leadenhall Street and Queens Road.

Limited Waiting One Hour

4. To limit to one hour in any period of two hours waiting by vehicles in the following two lengths of street, namely:

- (i) The north side of King Cross Road between the junction with West Royd Villas and No. 182 King Cross Road.
- (ii) The north side of King Cross Road between No. 194 King Cross Road and No. 232 King Cross Road.

Exceptions

5. Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit vehicles to wait in the lengths of street described in paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 above to pick up and set

down passengers, to load and unload goods, and in connection with any funeral, building operation, or demolition, or the maintenance of the roads or the services thereof.

PROVIDED THAT

for loading and unloading no vehicles shall so wait on any of the lengths of street described in paragraph 2 above between the hours of 8.15 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday.

6. Right hand turns with vehicles are forbidden at the following two points, viz.:

- (i) From Warley Road to Burnley Road
- (ii) From Burnley Road to Rochdale Road.

7. A copy of the proposed Order and a map indicating the lengths of street affected thereby are available for inspection at my office at the Town Hall during office hours.

Objections to these proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 20th March 1968.

HERNE BAY URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

Herne Bay Urban (Various Roads) (Waiting Restriction) Order 1968

Notice is hereby given that on 13th February 1968, the Herne Bay Urban District Council made an Order under section 1(1), (2) and (3) and section 2(4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which is to:

(a) prohibit the waiting of vehicles—

- (i) at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the First and Fifth Schedules hereto;
- (ii) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. each day during the period of 1st April to 30th September in each year in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (iii) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. each day during the period of 1st April to 30th September in each year in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto;
- (iv) at any time during the period of 1st April to 30th September in each year in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

Exemption from the waiting restrictions is provided in the Order to permit vehicles to pick up and set down passengers, to load and unload goods and to carry out essential services.

The Order also provides for revocation of "The County Council of Kent (Traffic Regulation) Order, No. 1, 1948".

The Order will come into operation on 1st April 1968.

Central Parade...	South	From a point 20 feet east to a point 20 feet west of its junction with Sea View Square.
Coopers Hill ...	Both	Both sides of its whole length north of points 20 feet north of its junction with Charles Street.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Name of Road	Side	Section
Western Esplanade ...	North	From a point opposite the west side of Victoria Drive to a point 255 feet west of the junction with Ridgeway Cliff.
	South	From its junction with Lane End to a point 255 feet west of the junction with Ridgeway Cliff.
Central Parade...	South	(a) From its junction with Lane End to its junction with Pier Avenue. (b) From a point 30 feet east of its junction with William Street to a point 30 feet west of its junction with Prospect Hill. (c) From a point 40 feet east of its junction with East Street to its junction with Canterbury Road.
	North	From the centre of the junction with Dolphin Street to a point 98 yards east of the Clock Tower.

THIRD SCHEDULE

Name of Road	Side	Section
St. George's Terrace ...	South	From its junction with Lane End to a point 30 feet west of its junction with Pier Avenue.

FOURTH SCHEDULE

Name of Road	Side	Section
Sea View Square ...	Both	Both sides from its junction with Central Parade southwards for a distance of 78 feet.

FIFTH SCHEDULE

Name of Road	Side	Section
Central Parade...	South	From a point 30 feet west of its junction with Market Street for a distance of 30 feet in a westerly direction.
