Barling Magna (No. 1) Public Path Extinguishment Order 1968

Notice is hereby given that the above Order made on the 27th day of March 1968 is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to extinguish the public right of way running from a point in Church Road, Barling Magna, 43 yards north-east of the junction of Church Road and Little Wakering Road and proceeding in a northerly direction along the access road to No. 1 Church Road for approximately 60 yards, thence in an easterly direction for approximately 10 yards and a northerly direction for approximately 305 yards to its termination in Mucking Hall Road, Barling Magna at a point approximately 187 yards west of Mill House.
