There shall be applied to the persons referred to in the Fourth Schedule to Our Warrant of 21st May 1955 the improvements in children's allowances and children's pensions authorised for members of the corresponding Armed Forces of the United Kingdom in Our Warrant of 12th February 1968 (Cmnd. 3530).
2. Any benefit granted under this Our Warrant may be withheld or reduced if the officer, or his children, are in receipt of any overlapping awards from the Ministry of Social Security by the amount of any such awards.
