CLEETHORPES BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Cleethorpes (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Cleethorpes Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be:

- (1) to prohibit, subject to the usual exemptions, the waiting of vehicles in Cambridge Street (part), Mill Road (part) and King's Road Extension; and
- (2) to exempt hackney carriages while waiting at a duly authorised hackney carriage stand from the prohibition on waiting on the East Side of Kingsway (C. 457).
