The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Regent Street and Valley Road) (One Way) Order, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to those lengths of road in column 2 of the said Schedule.

An exemption in the Order enables the use of mechanical road cleansing vehicles on the said lengths of road between the hours of 6 a.m. and 5 p.m.

A copy of the proposed Order and of a map showing the lengths of road in question may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of either (i) the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Room 87), County Hall, Wakefield, or (ii) the Hebden Royd Urban District Council, Council Offices, Hebden Bridge.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 21st May 1968.

That length of Regent Street which extends from its junction with Valley Road to its junction with Hangingroyd Lane.	From west to east.
That length of Valley Road which extends from its junction with Regent Street to its junction with St. Georges Street.	From north-east to south-west.
