The Enfield No. 16 Smoke Control Order, 1967

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th March 1968, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed with modification the above Order, which was made by the Enfield London Borough Council pursuant to their powers under section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956.

The Order relates to the area described in the Schedule hereto. If, after the date of coming into operation, on any day, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the area not exempted by the Order, the occupier of that building will be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding ten pounds unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel.
