PRESCRIBED TURN

4. To require that a left-hand turn only be made when driving a vehicle from Blenheim Street into Westmorland Road.

EXEMPTIONS

5. There are certain exemptions from the restrictions imposed in paragraphs 2 and 3. The vehicles specified in the third columns of Parts II, III, IV and VI, and in the second column of Part V of the Schedule are exempted from the provisions relating to the lengths of road specified opposite in the first column.
