

ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Essex, as highway authority, pursuant to section 108 of the Highways Act 1959, intend to apply to the Magistrates' Court sitting at the Shire Hall, Chelmsford on Thursday the 12th day of September 1968 at 10.30 a.m. for an Order authorising the diversion of the part of the highway described in the First Schedule to this notice to the new line described in the Second Schedule on the ground that the highway as diverted will be more commodious to the public.

The effect of the proposal is shown on a plan which is deposited at my office at the County Hall, Chelmsford and at the Post Office, Rettendon where it may be inspected free of charge during ordinary office hours.

On the hearing of the application any person to whom this notice has been given, any person who uses the highway described in the First Schedule and any other person who would be aggrieved by the making of the Order applied for will have a right to be heard.

FIRST SCHEDULE

South Hanningfield Road for a distance of 52 yards in a westerly direction from a point 30 yards west of its junction with the Chelmsford-Rayleigh Road (A.130) at The Bell Crossroads in the Parish of Rettendon in the Rural District of Chelmsford as shown coloured pink on the plan referred to above.

SECOND SCHEDULE

From a point on the said South Hanningfield Road 125 yards west of the said junction for a distance of 158 yards, in a north-easterly and easterly direction to a point on the said Chelmsford-Rayleigh Road 60 yards north of the said junction as shown coloured blue on the said plan.

*The Rural District of Godstone (Part of Footpaths Numbered 66 and 66A Hurst Green Junction, Oxted) Diversion Order, 1968.*

Notice is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 26th day of July 1968, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land in the Parish of Oxted in the Rural District of Godstone in the county of Surrey.

The effect of the Order will be to divert that part of footpath No. 66 from a point where it joins Nunappleton Way to a point approximately 300 feet north east thereof being the position of an existing stile and also to divert that part of footpath No. 66A from the wicket gate at the end of Nunappleton Way to a point approximately 90 feet north thereof, both paths to follow new lines commencing at the point where the footbridge joins Nunappleton Way to points approximately 152 feet north west and approximately 130 feet south east of the north east side of the footbridge.

*Hebden Royd Urban District Council (Savile Road) Footpath Diversion Order, 1968*

Notice is hereby given that on the 8th day of August 1968, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

Its effect is to divert with effect from the 3rd day of October 1968, the public right of way running from a point 20 feet or thereabouts to the west of Savile Road, Hebden Bridge and opposite to the premises No. 8 Prospect Terrace in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 17 feet or thereabout and thence in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 82 feet or thereabouts, to a line running from the said point to the west of Savile Road in a south-south-westerly direction for a distance of 39 feet or thereabouts and thence in a westerly direction for a distance of 61 feet or thereabouts to the point at which the new line coincides with the existing line.
