THE SCHEDULE

Lengths of road at Shotton in the Rural District of Hawarden

Bridge Street, Ryeland Street, Salisbury Street, King Edward Street, Alexandra Street. On both sides from a point 30 feet to a point approximately 120 feet from their junctions with Chester Road (A.548) and for the remaining lengths, alternate unilateral

Nelson Street. From a point 30 feet from its junction with Chester Road (A.548) alternate unilateral waiting.

Jubilee Street

Westerly side: the whole length.

Easterly side: from the junction with Chester Road (A.548) to a point near 38 Jubilee Street.

Ash Grove. On both sides from a point 30 feet to a point approximately 200 feet from its junction with Chester Road (A.548) and for the remaining length alternate unilateral waiting.

Rowden Street. On both sides from a point 30 feet to a point approximately 118 feet from its junction with Chester Road (A.548) and then alternate unilateral waiting to a point approximately 265 feet from the said junction.

Victoria Road. On both sides from a point 30 feet to a point approximately 120 feet from its junction with Chester Road (A.548) and then alternate unlateral waiting to its junction with Beaconsfield Road.

Chester Close. Alternate unilateral waiting from a point 30 feet from its junction with Chester Road (A.548) to its junction with St. David's Drive.

Wellington Street. Alternate unilateral waiting from a point 30 feet from its junction with Chester Road (A.548) to a point approximately 390 feet from the said junction.

FOLKESTONE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Eastern side from the southern end of the existing Order southwards for a distance of approximately 60 feet to a point opposite the northern side of the junction with Kingsnorth Gardens.

SCHEDULE II

(Amending prohibition between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. to a complete prohibition)

Alexandra Gardens. East side, from the corner Order at the junction with Sandgate Road to the corner Order at the south side of the junction with Oxford Terrace.
